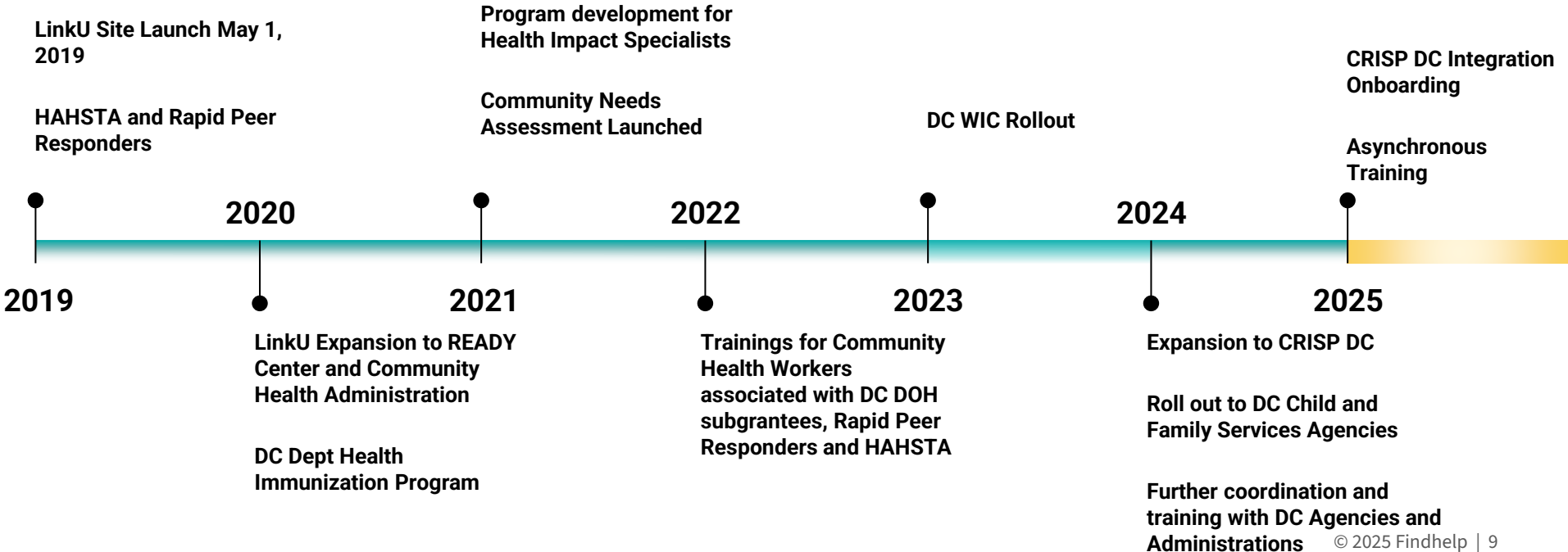
What is LinkU?

- LinkU, powered by findhelp.org, is a free online **community resource directory and e-referral platform** for DC residents, clients and community providers.
- LinkU connects the DC community with social care resources across the DMV region, and is also used to **track client outcomes** for various programs within the DC Department of Health and DC Department of Corrections (READY Center)

Social Needs Screener

- Use the Social Needs Screening tool to assess clients needs and find resources that meet their needs
- The completed assessment will generate suggested programs to streamline referrals that fit their needs.
- The answers will also be saved to the seeker's profile

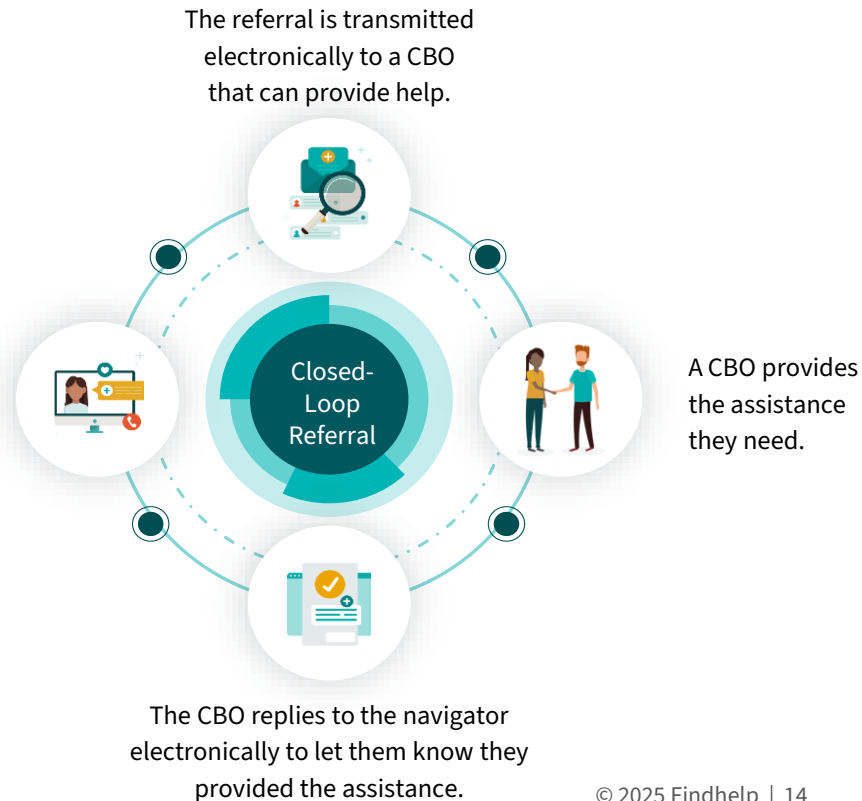

Refer to Programs

Referring a seeker to a program is directly connecting them with the next step to get the support or resource that program provides. This happens through live and logged referrals.

A navigator (like a social worker at a non-HIPAA covered organization) makes a referral for service on behalf of someone who needs help.





Program Management

[LinkU](#) empowers and supports Community Organizations to more easily and effectively help people in need of your services. One of the main ways organizations can access this support is by creating a free account and claiming their program(s).

Claiming your program allows you to access and update your program's information, create intake screeners and eligibility assessments, review reporting and analytics tools, and more – all for free!
